

Raffles galore – with prizes worth over £1000

Raising money for the World Championships.

The club has to raise a huge amount of money to put on this fantastic event, and we have been given two really excellent prizes, each one worthy of their own raffle..... so we're doing **two** raffles!!

First off, the main prize is a really gorgeous top of the range "Gold Leaf" real tennis racket, as used by the World Champion, but embossed in gold for "2017 World Doubles Championship", and we'll get it signed by the winners. An ordinary one for normal use, without the extra gold, retails at £250, so we'd like to think this would be worth at least double. As runner-up prizes there will be a £50 Prested Spa Voucher, and a "Prested Dinner B&B" voucher (for 2) worth about £150. We're very grateful to *Gold Leaf* for their generous support of the event.

The second raffle has as its main prize a year's full 7-day membership of the Notleys Golf Club down the road near Witham, and is worth £675. Notleys also has a 9-hole foot-golf course, and **all** course fees are included in your membership. This membership is transferable (once only, upon take-up) so you can give to a friend or sell on if you wish, but is not available to anyone who's been a member in the past three years. There are also two secondary prizes, the same as above. We are very grateful to *Notleys Golf Club* for their support, and we are happily supporting each other in promotions generally.

Tickets can be bought at reception or through the real tennis pro's, and please make sure they know which one you want. (Better still, have a go for both of them.)

Tickets are £5 each, or a string of five costs £20.

The draws will take place on the Sunday of the World Championships final, April 23rd, at lunch-time in the club-room.
